ABOUT THE COURSE

The course has been compiled in response to a demand from the marine insurance, legal and commodity trading community for a basic introduction to the issues surrounding dry bulk cargo quantity and quality disputes. Although the course is not intended to provide an in-depth study of scientific detail concerning bulk cargoes and thier properties, it does provide a varied programme of technical subjects structured for delegates who are not of a scientific discipline. Key general topics include the nature and types of dry bulk cargoes, their potential hazards, storage and carriage and examples/case studies of actual quantity and damage claims that MTD have investigated.

During the sessions delegates are invited to raise questions relevant to their sphere of business and have the opportunity to discuss technical issues with the scientists and mariners who are routinely engaged in dealing with such problems throughout the world.
